### New Additions to Library!

A 4-volume set of *Elsie Dinsmore* books has recently been added to the Juvenile Fiction section of the library. This series begins with Elsie, an 8-year-old Southern heiress, who is being raised by her nursemaid in the mid-1800s before the Civil War. Written in the 19<sup>th</sup> century by Martha Finley, these stories have been adapted for young readers today. Christian morals are strong in these books.

The 12-volume Christian History Series is now available for checkout in the library. The first book, titled *The Veil is Torn - A.D. 30 to A.D. 70 - Pentecost to the Destruction of Jerusalem*, has 19 chapters which include illustrations, maps, and short essays, along with the history commentary. A valuable resource for anyone interested in the history that has shaped Christianity today.
