New Additions to Library!

A 4-volume set of *Elsie Dinsmore* books has recently been added to the Juvenile Fiction section of the library. This series begins with Elsie, an 8-year-old Southern heiress, who is being raised by her nursemaid in the mid-1800s before the Civil War. Written in the 19th century by Martha Finley, these stories have been adapted for young readers today. Christian morals are strong in these books.

The 12-volume Christian History Series is now available for checkout in the library. The first book, titled *The Veil is Torn - A.D. 30 to A.D. 70 - Pentecost to the Destruction of Jerusalem*, has 19 chapters which include illustrations, maps, and short essays, along with the history commentary.
