Two Mission Trips with BMA's Voluntary Ministries Committee.

The Uganda trip previously scheduled for summer has been moved to early October. We are looking for 3-5 more people (particularly men of any age!) to join this team. We will be serving with Another Hope Children's Ministries in their orphanage, doing things like helping with farming, cooking, and day-to-day operations, as well as Bible teaching and village outreach. Approximate cost is \$1800/person.

The trip to Ixiamas, Bolivia has been rescheduled for November. We have room for 8 people. Activities will include singing and passing out tracts in the town square, participation in a community hymn sing (Spanish and English), work projects with host family, and interacting with and helping needy Bolivian families with projects like roofing, plumbing, agriculture, processing beans or yucca. We will also do some hiking and sight-seeing. Approximate cost is \$1,650.00/person.
