UPDATE: The Sabbatical Support Group (consisting of Wendell & Jeanene Nisly, James & Leanna Rhodes, Frank & Ann Good, Jason & Barb Beachy, and Steve & Rosa) met recently with the church council to discuss and explore a reintegration process for Brother Steve. Coming out of that conversation, the church council asked the Sabbatical Support Group to develop a proposal for what a healthy reintegration process might look like. The church council will then consider the proposal, and work at creating a plan of action.

The reintegration process will likely begin in January. One of our concerns is that Steve not return to a place of significant overload. Steve is improving, but regaining full health and emotional strength will likely require a good while yet. Thus, his reintegration into church work will be a gradual process over a period of time. It is a joy to see God at work and we encourage you to continue to pray for Steve, Rosa, and their family.
