Hello,

We are doing good. We had a neighborhood Christmas party .Many weeks of planning went into it. The couple days before were spent going around and gathering all the gifts. The students at the dorm practiced acting out the story of Joseph and Mary. The actual day of the Christmas party it didn't rain which was answered prayer. The event went off well although a bit chaotic. We had about 60 adults and 40 kids, plus our team and 11 dorm students. There were some neighbors around as well. We had singing, sermon, the drama of the Christmas story, food and gifts. Zeke and Zay along with their Sunday school class sang a song. Zeke and Zay just did the actions as they didn't know the words in Khmer. We are thankful for your support that enables us to be able to give gifts, and food to the people who we interact with a lot. For most of them, this is the only Christmas they got. With it being a Buddhist country, Christmas is a great time to share the gospel and about Jesus' birth with people. They are very open to learning about Christmas.

I, Stacey, have started homeschool again after the break. It's good to be back to routine. It feels like we are in a pretty intense time with our kids. They have so much energy. It's hard to know what to do with them all of the time. I've joined a homeschool coop and a PE class for the twins. They are also taking Khmer lessons from a tutor. They do not like their Khmer class. Trying to decide if we should continue them or not.

Dewey stays busy with Bible studies, saving groups through SALT, discipleship, and meeting with various people. There is also an endless list of things that need to be fixed, emails to send and people who want him to help them with various things.
